This has not been done to fulfill a requirement of a course, but with a great desire on the part of the students to share their faith. Over 30 people have heard the gospel through the witness of our students over the last two Saturdays.
4. Our school's heating system is working well and we have a warm building this winter!
5. TK left on January 5th to begin a three year term of service in Turkey.
6. ABI now has 6 former students serving in missions in Kosovo, Macedonia and Turkey!!!
7. The Lay Church Planters School that began on January 8-9 had an enrollment of 19 students.
