1. The students at ABI just completed the KAIROS course on world missions. It was a great success and everyone who attended had their eyes opened to the enormous needs for evangelization of the world, particularly in the 10/40 window. We had 10 guests take the course with our students.
2. Students are making progress in their classes on leading small groups and teaching chronological Bible lessons.
3. We have had several donations in the last month to our building fund, which leaves us only \$18,000 short of our needs. In January we were \$36,000 short.
4. One of our students, Gjergj, who was without work for most of this semester, has been able to go back to work part-time.
